Dear Member,

It gives me great pleasure to call for entries for our popular upcoming Junior Hunt for our junior members from the association. This exciting hunting opportunity is made available by **Karel Landman** from **Pongola Game Reserve**.

The hunt will take place during the upcoming school holiday and is aimed at our junior members aged between 12 – 17 years. This hunt follows on the KZN Hunters Junior Hunters Course and is a practical hunt. Thus, junior members whom are members of the association and whom completed and passed the Junior Hunters Course, will be given preference for this hunt which promises to be a lot of fun and excitement.

More details for your information as follows:

- Date: 24 to 28 March 2019 (4 nights)
- Venue: Pongola Game Reserve - Sondaba Hunting Camp
- Cost: R1,300 per junior hunter which includes food, beverage, use of hunting vehicles, tips for hunting guides and cleaners, ammunition, wood etc.
- Accommodation: **Sponsored by the Karel Landman Trust**
- Minimum age of hunter: 12 years
- Each junior hunter can shoot a non-trophy warthog - **meat to remain the property of the farm**
- Accommodation is self-catering and sleeps a maximum of 12 people
- We can only accommodate a limited number of participants. Once selected, payment will be required immediately to secure participation
- Regrettably transport is not provided to and from the venue, but we may be able to arrange some sort of lift club between parents
- Other animals are available for hunting at your own cost. This is however limited to one animal per hunter to give all the participants a fair chance to hunt. The cost of the additional animals will need to be paid directly to the Pongola Game Reserve's office. A price list will be provided, and a hunting licence is required for additional animals from the association office.

My goal is to give each participant an opportunity to hunt and harvest an animal over the period of the camp. Please note that this is not always possible. Please note:

- It is required that each participant is competent in handling a hunting rifle. A standard shooting test will need to be passed by all hunters on site to qualify to hunt.
- All rifles will be fitted with sound moderators/silencers to reduce the sound of gunshots in the reserve.
- An Indemnity will need to be signed by the parent or Legal Guardian of the child.

Please bear in mind that we have had regular great turnouts from juniors in the past during school holidays. I urge you to apply for your participation as soon as possible. Final information will be made available upon confirmation.

Below is a list of items that participants need to bring to the hunt:

- Torch
- Knife (no expensive knives)
- Personal toiletries
- Medication (if on medication)
- Sun protection (hat and sunscreen)
- Walking shoes
- Jacket and rain coat
- Mosquito and tick protection
- Pen and notebook
- Binocular (if possible)
