

Klipp Bros Shoot 2019



When the Dalton Rifle Club and New Hanover Gun Club amalgamated in 2018, a trophy donated by Klipp Bros, which had never been issued was returned. The DDRA stands for Dalton Defence Rifle Association, which was the original shooting Association in our area. From the English Hallmarks the trophy was made around 1953.

We, as a family, decided to start a rifle gong shoot with this trophy as a floating trophy. A further trophy, donated by Wilhelm Klipp (our grandfather) will be for the individual with the highest score. The trophies will not be handed to the team or individual.

Photos will be taken and the organizers of DRGC will engrave the trophy with the team name and the person with the highest score. In the event of a tie the team / individual with the longer range hits will win the trophy. For the team / individual to qualify for a trophy at least one / the member must be a member in good standing of DRGC. We will also present 10 x R100.00 gift vouchers from a shooting equipment shop as lucky draw prizes.

Date: Saturday 25th May 2019

Time: Briefing at 13h00 at the farm shed.

Venue: Beechwood Farm in the Fawn Leas area. Entrants will be supplied with a WhatsApp Pin to find their way to the venue. A WhatsApp Group will be created for participants for final arrangements.

2 man teams of which one member is either a member of the Dalton Rifle and Gun Club or a member of KZN Hunters.

Entry fee is R400.00 per team, which includes a braai pack and potato salad for an evening meal. Braai fires will be provided.

There is no lunch available. Bring your own hydration liquid, camping chair and drinks for after the shoot.

5 Ranges each requiring 5 shots. A total of 25 cartridges are required. All ranges are shot from left to right. Out of sequence shots are counted as misses. The range officer's call is final and no dissent will be tolerated. There is no sighting in facility, so please come prepared. No range finders or wind meters allowed. You may use your ballistic app. Time limits apply per team. Gong sizes vary from 100mm to 500mm. Distances will be from 150m to 420m. At each range we will let you know the distances to the closest and longest gong.

1	Rock shelf	Prone	Bipod and sand sock	Longest
2	Tank trap	Sitting	None	Intermediate
3	Logs	Sitting / Kneeling	None	Intermediate
4	Cattle Kraal	Standing	None	Shortest
5	Sandbags	Prone	None	Intermediate

Any form of rifle strap may be used. You may use a shooting mat and a thin piece of material for rifle protection.

As the shoot takes place in the Veld, please bring your own "white gold". The shed meeting area has no ablution facilities. There is potable water available at a tap.

You will be required to sign an indemnity before any shooting takes place.

Nominated members of the DRGC Committee have the final say in disputes.
